Only full papers may be submitted, preferably in pdf-format. Papers should be submitted to ikostakis@hua.gr/iekostakis@gmail.com

Deadline for paper submission is July 30, 2016.

Authors are allowed to submit more than one paper. We will confirm receipt of your submission.

All submitted papers will be peer reviewed according to a high-quality and fast referee process. You will receive an e-mail indicating whether your paper is accepted for presentation during the workshop or not before August 10, 2016.

Paper presenters are expected to discuss one other paper during the workshop. The discussant assignments will be made by the workshop organizers at a later date. As the workshop intends to build a network in this research area, participation is welcome even without paper contributions.

Publication of Papers

INFER offers several publication possibilities to workshop participants, including book volumes and journal publications.
